CEO's Report and Highlights 2023

e had a very successful year in 2023 in many aspects. The year reported a steady rise in the number of patients that we served in the base hospital as well as outreach and vision Centres. We did the highest number of cataracts surgery in the year, [2,414] more than any other previous year since inception. Added to almost 900 other eye surgeries done, makes over 3,300 total surgeries that we did in 2023. This is the year that we opened our second Vision Centre in Ogembo town that has report a very encouraging success in its first year of operation. Our partnerships both locally and internationally have not only been maintained but also strengthened.

The Programmes with our key partners, the University of Michigan, Fred Hollows Foundation, Operation Eyesight Universal, Fiat Lux Foundation,



the Aravind Eye Hospital, the Rwanda International Institute of Ophthalmology, and the University of Nairobi were maintained at the peak and that saw us able to perform our function of offering quality eye care to ALL in the community getting more strengthened. The Eye Foundation Nigeria started working more closely with us, especially in business support to enable expansion to Kisumu. We just completed the renovation and equipping of the Kisumu branch and hope to start the operations in the first quarter of 2024. This will see us bring our much sought after services closer to the population in Kisumu City and the surrounding counties that number over 4 million. Our new partner, the Vision Spring is working with us in a unique model to strengthen our ability to reach to the millions of the Uncorrected Refractive Errors in the community.

Our workforce has been amazing in working through great challenges to continue to offer very high standards of eye care. We have continued to internally train new members of the team both in administration and clinical areas to enable increase the much sought after human resource in eye health that is key to meet the huge eye care needs in our region. The testimonies from our patients on the quality of care received from our us is always very encouraging.

As we approach the year 2024 and beyond, we feel energized to expand our services and reach out to more. Key to this will be to operationalize our services in Kisumu City, create more vision Centres, and keep increasing a well-trained team of eye care staff. A region free of avoidable blindness is now becoming a reality.

Vision Spring – Provision of Affordable Quality Low Cost Eye Glasses at Community Outreach Programmes

Innovation Eye Centre - Kisii Eye Hospital and Vision Spring Kenya Partnership aims at providing low-cost spectacles at our outreach programme. 5,264 patients were screened and 989 low-cost spectacles dispensed in Outreach programmes.

Right to Sight, Norway and Ministry of Health Kisii County - Diabetic Retinopathy Screening Programme

The Diabetic Retinopathy screening 6 months pilot programme was carried out from November 2022 to May 2023 in partnership with Right to Sight-Norway and the Ministry of Health Kisii County at South Mugirango, Kisii County.

The purpose of the project was to increase awareness of diabetes and diabetic eye diseases. 19,336 patients were screened in the community by community health volunteers, and 825 patients were referred to the Kisii County Health Centers for diabetes treatment. 95 patients were identified with diabetes retinopathy and 46 patients were treated at Innovation Eye Centre – Kisii Eye Hospital for diabetes retinopathy.

Uncorrected Refractive Error Research by Peek Vision Kenya and Operation Eyesight Universal

Innovation Eye Centre- Kisii Eye Hospital joined hands with Peek Vision Kenya and Operation Eyesight Universal to conduct research on Uncorrected Refractive Error for a period of six months May –Dec 2023 at Bomachoge Chache Sub County. A group of eight screeners was selected and trained to conduct doorto-door survey screening using the Peek Vision Application with mobile phones and thereby referring to Ogembo Vision Centre all persons of age 40 years and above. In this regard, 18,389 patients were screened in the community of which 9,789 included patients above 40 years of age. 7,520 patients above 40 years were referred to the vision Centre with refractive errors and other eye conditions. 1,320 patients were registered at the vision center. 488 spectacles and 243 medicines were dispensed respectively.








World Diabetes Day 2023 Celebrations




