EYE CAMP AT NDIWA CONSTITUENCY, HOMABAY COUNTY

Innovation Eye Centre – Kisii recently concluded a three-day eye camp in Ndiwa Constituency, Homabay County, bringing vital eye care services to the local community. The camp, held on the 22nd, 23rd, and 24th of August, was sponsored by Ndiwa Constituency Member of Parliament, Mr. Martin Owino. Its primary aim was to address the pressing need for eye health services in the region, particularly among underserved populations.

During the camp, a total of 1,400 patients were screened for various eye conditions. Among those screened, 53 individuals were diagnosed with cataracts, one of the leading causes of blindness.
