## WORLD SIGHT DAY 2024 CELEBRATIONS

In honor of World Sight Day, Innovation Eye Centre proudly joined global efforts to raise awareness about vision impairment and the critical importance of eye health. This event, celebrated worldwide, served as an invaluable opportunity for the Centre to engage with the community, educate on preventive measures, and reinforce our mission to combat preventable vision loss.

Our outreach team organized eye camps at Eberege Dispensary and Itibo Dispensary to bring essential eye care services closer to the community. At Eberege Health Centre, 116 patients were screened, and 15 successful surgeries were performed at Innovation Eye Centre - Kisii. Meanwhile, at Itibo Dispensary, 36 patients received screenings. Over the World Sight Day week, a total of 46 surgeries were successfully conducted.

Through these camps, we not only provided screenings and surgeries but also raised awareness about the importance of regular eye check-ups. By reaching out to communities directly, Innovation Eye Centre remains dedicated to improving eye health and quality of life in our region.

# MERCY FOUNDATION PARTNERSHIP

Innovation Eye Centre - Kisumu proudly participated in a four-day medical camp organized by the Mercy Foundation across Kisumu, Siaya, and Homabay counties in October 2024. The camp provided free eye screening services to 1,066 patients, underscoring the commitment to accessible eye care. Of those screened, 64 patients were recommended for cataract surgery, offering a pathway to restored vision.


