## **Innovation Eye Centre Participates in World Sickle Cell Day Commemoration in Kisumu**

Innovation Eye Centre was honored to take part in the World Sickle Cell Day commemoration held in Kisumu on 12th May 2025, joining hands with various medical facilities to offer vital health services to the local community.

The event, organized as a medical camp, brought together healthcare providers, advocacy groups, and community members to raise awareness about sickle cell disease and provide free medical checkups, consultations, and health education.

During the event, a total of 76 People were screened for sickle cell disease by Innovation Eye Centre.

Held as part of an ongoing road safety awareness campaign, the event aimed to assess and improve the visual health of drivers, boda boda operators, and other road users whose eyesight is critical to their day-to-day operations.

During the event, a total of 63 Drivers were screened and received professional advice on vision care.

The objective of the training was to equip screeners at community level with the necessary knowledge and skills to effectively implement the EARN Trial Research Project which was to start on July 2025. This initiative focuses on enhancing eye health outcomes through evidence-based interventions and collaborative research.

## **Restoring Sight and Hope: June Outreach Camp Success**

In June, our team conducted a series of successful eye care outreach camps in Nyiwir, Ramba, Mokomoni, Ndisi, Sosera, and Nyamboyo. These camps aimed to bring essential eye services closer to underserved communities. Patients were screened for cataracts, refractive errors, glaucoma, and other eye conditions. As a result, 160 cataract surgeries were successfully performed, restoring sight and transforming lives. Many other patients received immediate treatment, while some were referred for specialized care. The outreach also raised awareness on eye health and the importance of regular check-ups. We thank local leaders and communities for their continued support.
