During the workshop, Everlyne Ongeta made a presentation on outreach strategies. The meeting focused on strengthening cataract services and reaffirmed the Centre’s commitment to delivering accessible, high-quality eye care across Kenya.

## **Innovation Eye Centre Outreach in Belgut**

Innovation Eye Centre recently held a major eye camp in Belgut, Kericho County, bringing quality eye care closer to the community. The camp reached over 700 people, who were screened for cataracts, refractive errors, and other vision conditions.

Following the screenings, 94 successful cataract surgeries were performed at Innovation Eye Centre in Kisii, restoring sight to patients who had endured significant visual impairment.

The team also used the event to raise awareness on preventive eye care and the importance of early diagnosis, noting that cataracts remain a leading cause of avoidable blindness in Kenya.

Through such outreach programs, Innovation Eye Centre continues to fulfill its mission of providing accessible, affordable, and high-quality eye care to underserved communities, transforming lives and giving hope to many families.
