Bringing Quality Eye Care Closer to Underserved Communities

As part of our ongoing commitment to eliminating avoidable blindness and expanding access to quality eye care, Innovation Eye Centre conducted a series of community outreach eye screening camps in underserved and low-resource areas throughout June 2026. These initiatives are designed to ensure that vulnerable populations can access essential eye care services regardless of geographical or financial barriers.

The outreach camps focused on the early detection and management of preventable and treatable eye conditions, with particular emphasis on cataracts one of the leading causes of avoidable blindness. Community members received comprehensive eye examinations, professional counselling, and appropriate referrals for specialized treatment where required.

As a direct result of these outreach activities, 66 cataract surgeries were successfully performed, restoring sight and significantly improving the quality of life for patients who may otherwise have remained visually impaired due to limited access to specialized ophthalmic care.
